
# JHALAWAR

#### 1887 - 90

THE POSTAGE STAMPS OF THALAWAR CONSISTED OF ONLY TWO VALUES - ONE PICE AND QUARTER ANNA. EACH IS PRINTED IN STRIPS OF 12 STAMPS ON LAID PAPER THE ONE PICE VALUE DEPICTS AN APSARA "RHEMBA" A DANCING NYMPH OF THE HINDU PARADISE. THE INSCRIPTIONS ARE IN HINDI AND URDU READING "RAJ JHALALAR" AT THE SIDES AND "EK PAISA" LE, "ONE PICE" AT TOP AND BOTTOM.



#### SHAPES AND PAPERS OF THE # ANNA :-

THERE ARE A GREAT RANGE OF BOTH WHICH MAKES THEM DIFFICULT TO CLASSIFY ALL PAPERS ARE LAND, USUALLY VERTICAL, AND THE PRINCIPLE TYPES ARE:-(A) PURE WHITE , MEDIUM THICK ; (B) WHITE - OFF-WHITE , THIN ; (C) TONED THICK AND (D) TONED MEDIUM





AN ASHTA'AM FROM JHALAWAR STATE

This uhusual fiscal is a statutory form obtainable on payment of a fee for the execution or registration of contracts, application to Courts etc. The fee ( = 1 Anna) varied according to the size and nature of the contract. Several Native States used these forms but examples from such a State as Jhalawar are quite scarce.
