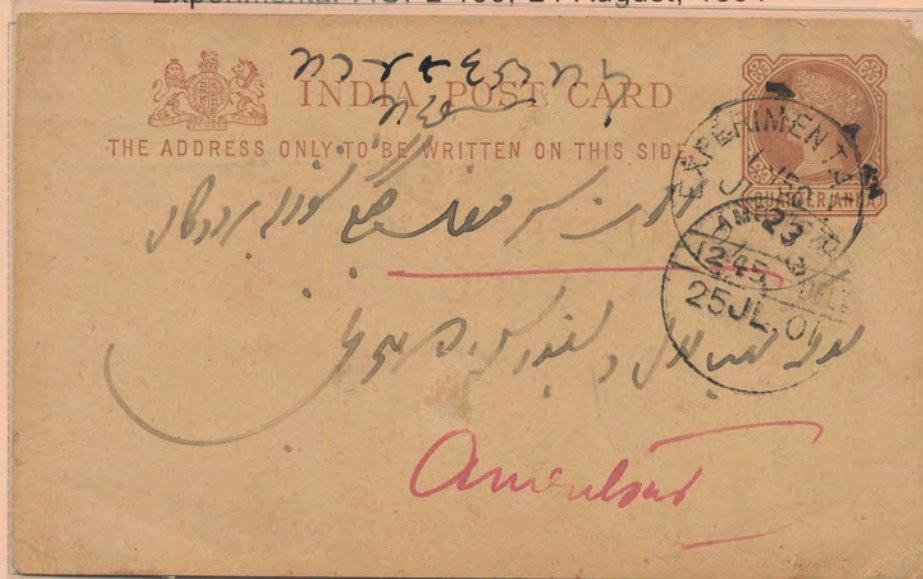

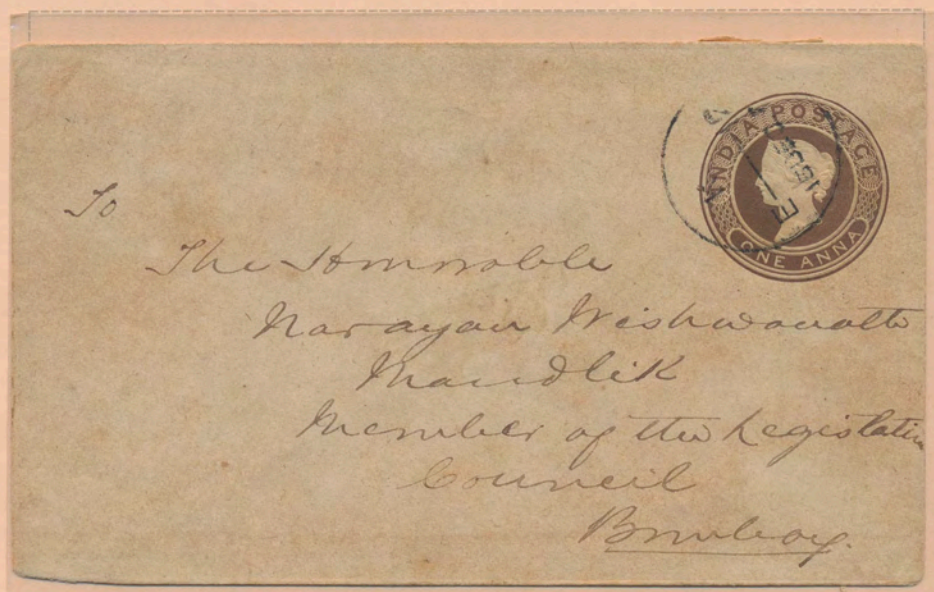

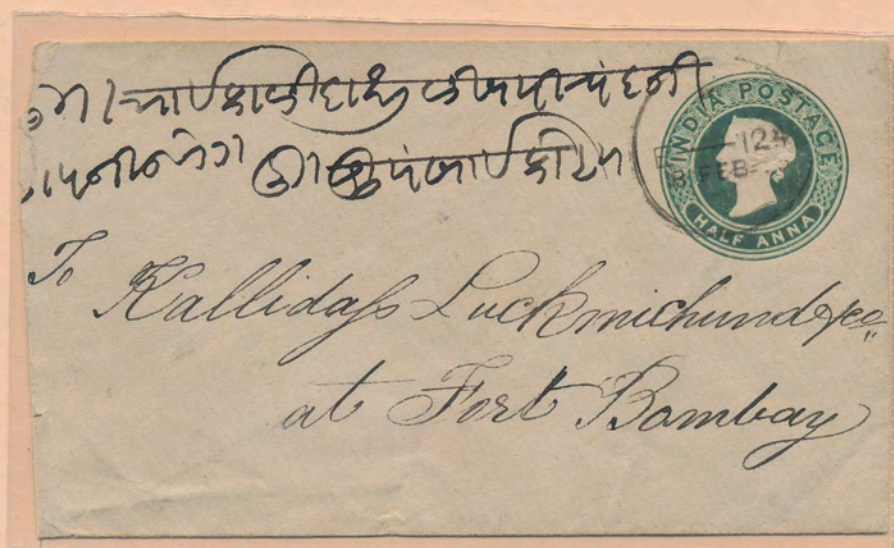

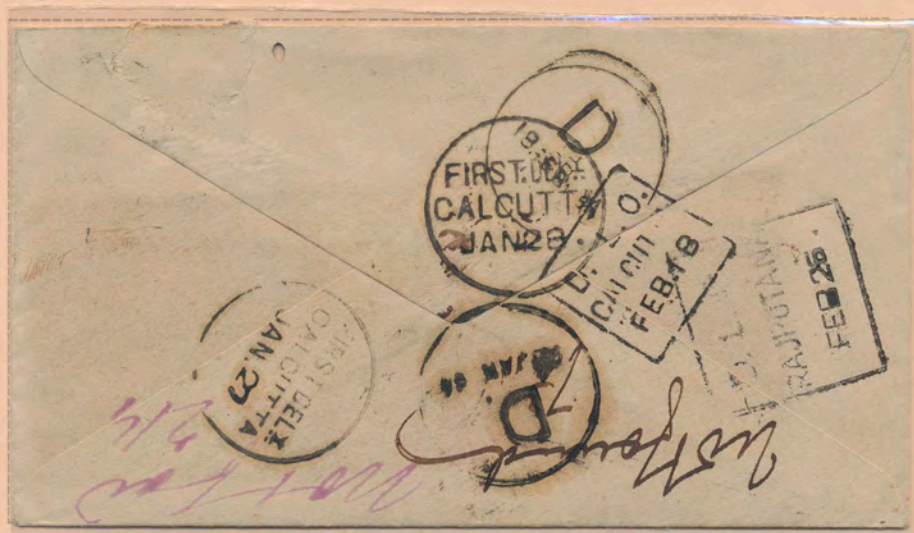

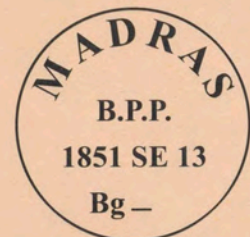

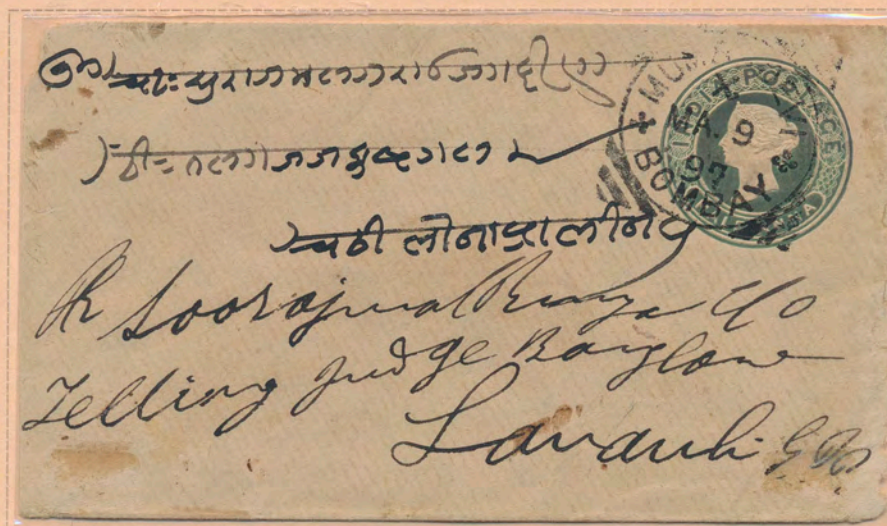
A most interesting example of a letter which did not get started on its journey. Posted in ONGOLE Madras on 23rd Sept. 1892 when the Postage Due was applied, it acquired the "Bombay-F" (postmark for foreign mail) on 27th Sept. When it was discovered that the full postage to Canada was compulsory and the very rare "Prepayment Compulsory" postmark was struck. Landed in Bombay D.L.O. 27th Sept. and Madras D.L.O. 5th Oct. 1892.

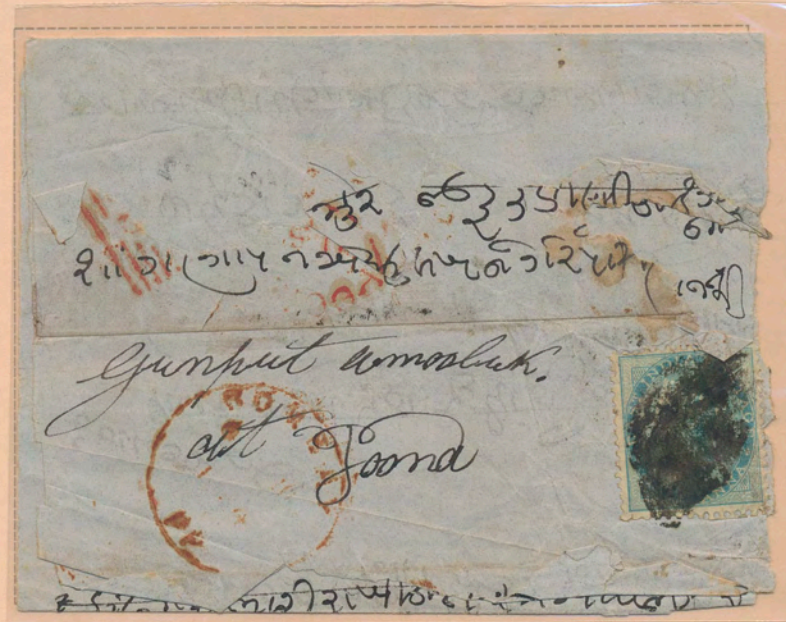
Note : 10as. 8ps. rate via Brindisi & Germany was used during an experimental period from 17 NOV. 1869 to 19 OCT. 1870 when it displaced the Marseilles route. This route paid for both the transit charges over Italy and France. On 10 DEC. 1870 the route was relieved of the French charge and the rate became 8as.

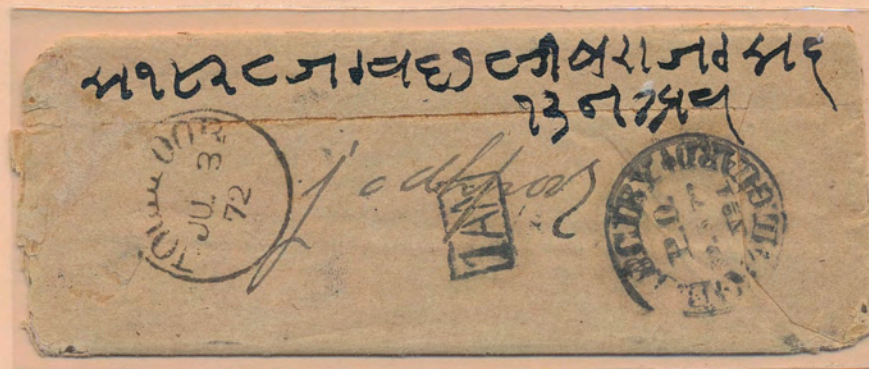
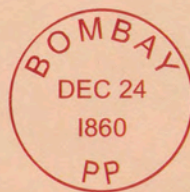

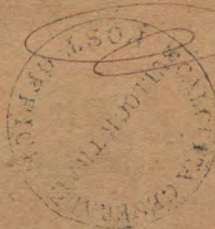
