PREPAYMENT COMPULSORY R. A. P.

A most interesting example of a letter which did not get started on its journey. Posted in ONGOLE Madras on 23rd Sept. 1892 when the Postage Gue was apphed, it aquired the "Bombay-F" (postmark for foreign mail) on 27th Sept. When it was discovered that the full postage to Canada was compulsory and the very rare "Prepayment Compulsory" postmark was struck. Landed in Bombay D.L.O. 27th Sept. and Madras D.L.O. 5th Oct. 1892.


